

Hygiene Concept Hurricane Factory Berlin GmbH - close contact services

1. Preamble

The following individual hygiene concept of Hurricane Factory Berlin serves primarily as protection of clients, athletes, and staff at close contact services. It is meant to obviate a virus infection with COVID-19, to prevent chains of infection and also to interrupt chains of infection with suitable measures. To obviate an infection reasonably, the following items are an inherent part of the hygiene concept:

- a. access for vaccinated and recovered persons only**
- b. observing of the minimum distance (1,5 m)**
- c. the wear of a surgical mask according to the actual state ordinance**
- d. regular hand hygiene**
- e. individual test strategy**

2. Implementation

a. Conditions to enter the building and test strategy

- before entering the building, the self-test questionnaire of Hurricane Factory Berlin GmbH regarding infection protection (see homepage www.hurricanefactory.com & attachment 1) has to have a „negative“ outcome
- persons considered as recovered and persons considered to be immunized against the Corona virus SARS-COV-2, are presumed to be negative conformable to COVID-19-Schutzmaßnahmen-Ausnahmenverordnung §1 Nr.1, provided that they are asymptomatic. In this case an according proof has to be furnished
- the proof has to be provided in material or digital form and the existence of the proof has to be confirmed by the signature of the client
- for minors apply the following rules:
 - minors less than 6 years: exemption of the test obligation
 - school children: school children, who are tested regularly due to the effective state ordinance in connection with their school attendance, do not need an additional test to visit Hurricane Factory Berlin
 - other minors: for minors which do not attend school, the negative result of a self or rapid test not older than 24 h is sufficient (or a negative PCR test result not older than 48 h), a legal guardian confirms the negative test result by signature
- an appointment booking is obligatory to regulate and limit the maximal permissible number of persons in the building
 - upon appointment booking the number of companions has to be stated by the client
 - for all companions apply identical entry requirements
- for the purposes of contact tracing the personal data (name, address, phone) of all persons in the building will be gathered and stored for 4 weeks

b. Behavior in the service building

- a minimum distance of 1,5 m has to be maintained
 - according floor marks and information signs have to be respected
 - the lift may be used by 2 persons from different households at the most, children until the age of 6 do not count in this context
- a medical face mask according to the actual state ordinance has to be worn (surgical mask or FFP2 mask)
- the itineraries according to the marks and signs have to be followed
- it is requested to follow the recommendations of the RKI (Robert Koch Institute):
 - mind frequent hand hygiene
 - adhere to cough and sneeze etiquette
- for the sanitary areas applies *the one person per room* rule
- general abdication of social proximity, provided that the according federal state ordinance does not permit something else

c. Behavior in the wind tunnel and the pre-flight chamber

- the air volume in the wind tunnel amounts to more than 2.500 m³. By the means of the air exchange facilities, about 25 % of this volume can be replaced by fresh air every 4 seconds during operation. Therefore, in the antechamber and the wind tunnel prevail comparable conditions to an outdoor activity for the athletes.
- the athletes - and the required instructor for reasons of safety - wear a complete protective equipment. This contains:
 - whole body flight suit
 - helmet
 - protection goggles
 - gloves
 - ear protection
- in the antechamber and the wind tunnel exist a permanent strong airflow (up to 285 km/h in the flight chamber). An infection here is generally impossible, approximately comparable with two bikers which drive side by side on a freeway.
- through the antechamber blows a permanent airstream. Therefore, all clients in the preflight chamber and the wind tunnel are situated in the above described total volume of the wind tunnel which is permanently supplied with fresh air. Due to the protective gear and the permanent strong surrounding air flow there is no necessity of a safety distance.
- during the stay in the building and throughout the air traffic there is no direct physical contact.

3. Hygiene rules

the operators provide a sufficient amount of hygiene products (hand disinfection, lavatories, soap etc.). A disinfection of the notably stressed infrastructure is ensured. The following areas belong to the items which have to be disinfected several times a day:

- entrance area
 - door handles and all grips
 - stair railing
 - operating elements of the lift
- reception
 - all highly frequented surfaced
 - computer keyboards, mice and screens
 - daily stationary
 - operating elements as cash register, EC devise etc.
- wind tunnel – control chamber and elements
 - all highly frequented surfaces
 - driver pannel and control levers
- WC
 - door handles
 - faucets and sinks
 - toilets and urinals
- fresh air supply
 - regular venting by opening of the windows and the in-house ventilation system with 50 % fresh air supply
 - regular control through the monitoring station for ambient air

4. Supervision of the orderly implementation

To supervise the orderly implementation of the above listed items, two staff members of Hurricane Factory Berlin GmbH will be appointed as hygiene representatives. These representatives will be named in due course and the local health authorities will be notified accordingly.

5. Personnel

- a. The personnel of Hurricane Factory has to be vaccinated or recovered or/and tested before entering the building
- b. The daily test (SARS-COV-2 lay test) has to be executed and verified under instruction of an authorized appointee. An approved test certificate can be issued by the employer on demand.
- c. On the part of the management the domestic authority is exercised, therefore there is no waiver of the test obligation for vaccinated or recovered personnel to prevent the actual rate of new infections.
