

Power of attorney for checking in minors

Minors require a declaration of consent from a legal guardian in order to fly in the wind tunnel. If the minor is accompanied by a parent, this declaration of consent can be completed on site.

Alternatively, the legal guardian can grant the accompanying person power of attorney in advance to check in the child. The completed and signed power of attorney must be presented at check in together **with a copy/photo of the legal guardian's identity card.**
